# How do I get counted?

1. Invitations to respond will be mailed to households beginning March 12. Save the census ID number mailed to you to respond.
2. Respond online ([my2020census.gov](https://my2020census.gov)), by phone or by mail.
3. Beginning in May, census takers will visit homes that have not yet responded.

## FYI:

- Everyone counts – Make sure to count newborn babies and young children.
- Your answers are confidential. By law your responses can only be used to create statistics.
- The questionnaire should take you about 10 minutes to complete.
